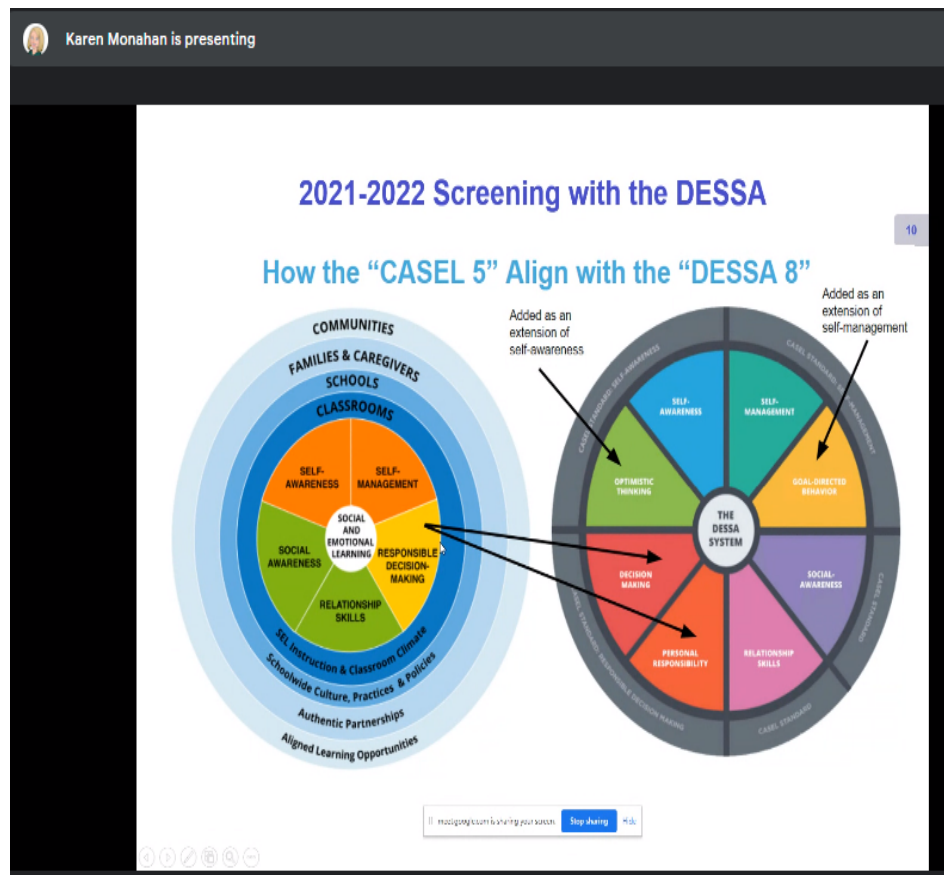

 - Cognia Summary - In the near future, it will be available on our district's site as we just completed the (virtual) process in November 2021. Based on 31 standards, the evaluators were able to capture what was going well and needs for improvement. Autonomy and Equity were areas to focus on, as district. We were found to be impacting on 10 of the standards. Only 1 area was at level of initiate (area of improvement) related to "Learners have equitable opportunity to develop skills and achieve the learning priorities established by the system". The district identified this area and working to improve.
 - SGP Report Analysis - Reading and Math of the STAR (computerized assessment) provides data about how students are mastering standards. The SGP (Student Growth Report) is generated and analyzed by our Literacy/Numeracy Coach and Administrators alongside the teacher to make instructional decisions.
