

Placement for 9th Grade Biology

During the spring of the 8th grade year, Randolph Middle School teachers make determinations of 9th grade placement based on several factors: Science Skills Assessment score, Winter MAPs scores in reading and math, and teacher’s assessment of academic skills and study skills. Students will receive points based on the criteria in the table below that will determine where teachers recommend students to be placed for 9th grade Biology. Students have the ability to select a level lower than what a teacher recommends.
