

**Derry Township School District  
Military Recruitment Opt Out Form**

The Education Reform Act of 2002 contains a provision that school districts provide, on a request by military recruiters, access to secondary school students' names, addresses, and telephone listings. The Derry Township School District is obligated to provide the directory information of 11th and 12th grade students to military recruiters unless directed by a parent/guardian that such information not be released. If you do not wish to have the directory information released to the military recruiters, you must inform the principal in writing no later than the third Friday in September. If notification is not received by this date, student directory information will be released as specified.
