SUPERINTENDENT’S COMMITTEE REPORTS

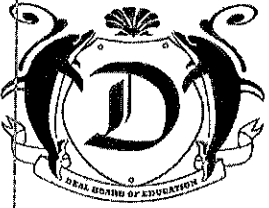

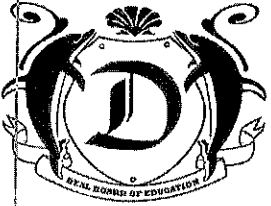
