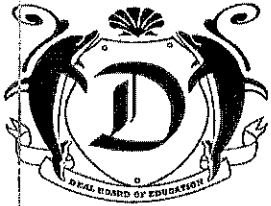

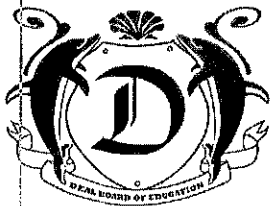

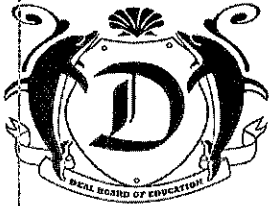
Deal has a send / receive relationship with sending students to Shore Regional High School due to having less than the 3% population attending the high school we do not have enough representation to have a seat on the board of education.

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
Be It Further resolved, that no formal action will be taken by the Board of Education during this closed session.
