Dear Parent(s) or Guardian,

The special education rules related to accessing Medicaid reimbursement for health related IEP services have changed, effective March 18, 2013.

In the past, you signed a parental consent for the school district to seek partial reimbursement from Medicaid for health related services provided to your child. Instead of signing a parental consent each year, the district will provide you with an Annual Notification of your rights. The information in the annual notification is the same information provided to you when you signed a parental consent.

Annual Notice: Medicaid Reimbursement

Medicaid allows school districts to seek reimbursement for certain costs covered under the federal program. The reimbursements are essential to our ability to provide health services and other services to our students with disabilities. As such, we are providing a required notice of your rights associated with this program, which requires those students eligible to have signed parental consent. No further action is necessary.
