

Donations

It is the policy of the Cherokee County Board of Education (“School Board”) to accept or deny donations from any source. Upon acceptance by the School Board, all donations become the property of the School District. It is also the policy of the School Board to encourage donations from any legitimate sources, including student support organizations. However, in order to assist the School District in maintaining compliance with the Georgia Equity in Sports Act, any donations made to athletic programs of the School District and accepted by the School Board must be accompanied by either a valuation of such donation or an accounting of actual costs incurred by the donor regarding the donations. The Superintendent will establish criteria for the evaluation of offers and acceptance of donations to the School District. Donations may include real or personal property, as well as donations of services. The School District will only consider receipts of donations that conform to state and federal laws and to policies of the School Board, including but not limited to, any applicable safety standards.
