## Counseling Services:

The goal of the counselor is to take a preventative, instructional approach to providing counseling and guidance lessons and activities for all students.

The elementary counselor provides whole group guidance lessons for every class once a week for all students.

The counselor assists with academic supports, collaborating with teachers to provide appropriate learning and behavioral supports for students.

The counselor provides intentional guidance for students in large groups, small groups, and/or individual settings.



The counselor is responsive in crisis situations; consults and collaborates with families, administrators, school staff, community agencies, and other resources to support students.

The counselor monitors data to facilitate student success; participates in leadership teams to provide support and strategies to close the achievement gap.

## What Is The ASCA National Model?

The ASCA National Model brings school counselors together with one vision and one voice, which creates unity and focus toward improving student achievement.

The ASCA National Model ensures equitable access to education for all students, identifies the knowledge and skills of students, is based on data-driven decision making, is provided by a state-credentialed school counselor and is delivered to all students in a systematic fashion.

School counselors work collaboratively with parents, administration and other educators to create an environment that promotes student achievement.
