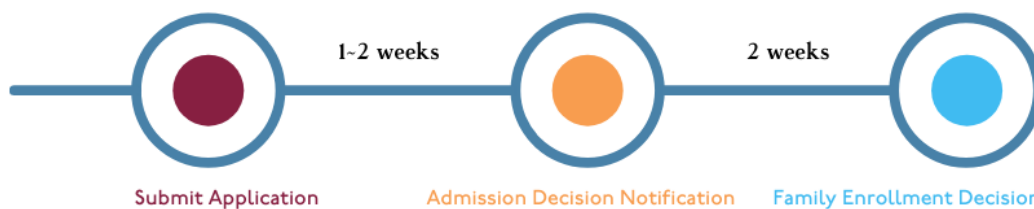

**English proficiency test:* Students who are native speakers of English, or who have been enrolled in a school where English has been the main medium of instruction for the last 2 years are exempt from the test requirement. If a student is not a native speaker and/or the main language of instruction in their school has not been English, we will need an English exam result (TOEFL, IELTS, Cambridge (CAE), Duolingo English test).

- Once your application is submitted, you can expect an Admission Decision within 2 weeks.
- Once your Admission Decision has been notified, you will have 2 weeks to accept enrollment by paying the one-time enrollment fee to confirm your spot in the school.
