Strategies

- Majority of strategies focus on teacher behaviors that increase student achievement
- Selected strategies are research-based
- Chosen strategies have an effect size on student achievement of 1 or more year's growth
- Most commonly selected strategies:
 - Growing collective teacher efficacy
 - Increasing positive student to teacher relationships
 - Providing timely and collaborative feedback to students
 - Using common formative assessments
 - Continuing the work of the Professional Learning Communities (PLCs)
 - Providing direct instruction in reading and math
 - Providing support through key instruction practices such as reciprocal teaching, scaffolding, micro teaching and concept mapping
 - Utilizing self-reporting grades and goal setting
 - Increasing rigor, relevance and learner engagement in the classroom

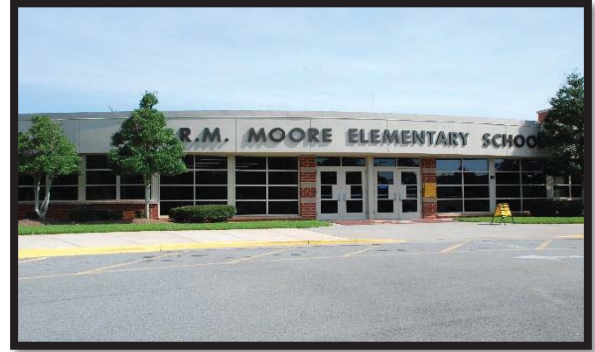
