



2020-2021 Teacher Grant Guidelines

The Freedom Middle School PTSA is committed in its offering of teacher grants to be distributed for the 2019-2020 school year. Grant requests will be fulfilled on a one time only basis. **The deadline to submit your grant request is February 1, 2021.**

The PTSA's purpose of these grants is to assist teachers with needs that will benefit all students and to help develop the highest advantages for them. The PTSA is committed to distributing all grant funds available.

- Every applicant must be a FMS teacher and a current member of the FMS PTSA.
- Each teacher may apply for only one grant per school year.
- Each grant award will be for a maximum of \$200.
- Additional monies up to \$600 total may be awarded for grants that cover multiple teachers, an entire team or entire grade (the more students the grant impacts, the more money available)
- Each grant must be for educational purposes only.

Grant requests will be reviewed by the PTSA officers and the PTSA is not required to award the maximum, but may award a lesser amount.

When a grant is approved, the applicant must purchase the approved item(s) and turn in a receipt to the PTSA treasurer for reimbursement or provide a PO from the school bookkeeper. The reimbursement cannot exceed the grant amount.

All property purchased with PTSA funds will remain the property of Freedom Middle School or for the use of Freedom Middle School students.
