

# Community Council Meeting February 9, 2023

## Minutes

**In Attendance:** Rich Swanson (via TEAMS), Brenda Bacon, Jill Lacy, Mike Call, JD Griffith, Tristen Beck, Paulynn Hacking, Jon Hunter, Sarah Cressap, Tim Allen (admin), Mylei Zachman (admin), various community members as guests.

### Agenda Items:

1. Sarah said her responsibility as a member of community council is to represent her constituents. She feels the community wants Summit to be done and that it doesn't work for all students. She stated she feels that there is space for different classes for students with different needs. She invited via a facebook group, "Parents concerned about Summit Learning in school" multiple local community members. Various community members voiced their concerns including one who is a software engineer and shared some numbers regarding employees at each of their companies. Mr. Shell said security is actually his concern as well as complaints that there isn't a possibility for updating.

Council Member Hunter asked what a "traditional" classroom looks like to which Council Member Cressap stated is more direct instruction and hard deadlines.

Mr. Griffith stated that as a researcher one needs to look more at outcomes. That for him it is all about the adaptive learning and allowing. One example shared was at BYU they use up to 6 learning management systems.

Principal Swanson talked to the importance of keeping uniformity of learning platforms, especially for teachers.

2. Trustlands and SIP Discussion

The majority of monies goes to teachers and productivities, prep time, etc. Helps FHS keep class sizes lower. \$45,000 were opened up last year to teacher grants. Teachers could apply and the council would review the applications. Of that last year over \$42,000 were used toward classroom improvement. Mr. Swanson asked if this is something we would like to use again? The council said yes.

We also used some of these monies to upgrade our computer in a three year cycle instead of the district 4 year cycle.

Mr. Griffith motioned to approve using the extra funds and Mr. Hunter seconded the motion. It was unanimous
