The WIS Primary School After School Program is a safe and international community for children, with programs to expand knowledge and build life skills through hands-on learning adventures.

Spring Term 2023

Spring Term After School classes begin on Monday, April 3, 2023 and will run every day school is in session through Friday, June 9, 2023 (except for half days on April 7 and May 26). *Note:* On Monday & Tuesday, June 12 & 13, Co-Curricular Programs will offer Extended Day Care ONLY. Students who are registered under the spring contract for Extended Day Care will be covered until June 13. For those who are only registered for after school classes and want to use Extended Day Care on June 12 & 13, parents can register through CampBrain for an additional cost of \$45.00 per day.

About this Document

This catalogue is designed to allow families to make detailed selections for after school activities. On any given day, a student may stay until 6:00 PM in the after school program as long as the student is enrolled in a class, enrolled in Extended Day Care (EDC), or enrolled in music lessons. The weekly view shows what classes are offered for each age group on each day. In the pages that follow, detailed descriptions of classes are included. The final section of this document has a description of the After School Music Program, which features biographical information for all music instructors.

To select a class, please proceed to the spring online registration form in CampBrain, which also lists additional Co-Curricular Programs services that will be offered throughout the term. *Registration will open in CampBrain on Monday, February 27 at 12:00 PM EST and all registrations must be submitted via CampBrain by 5:00 PM EST on Friday, March 17, 2023.* Enrollment is completed on a first-come, first-served basis and families will be notified only if there are any changes for the class of their choice. *See registration instructions on Page 3.*

Fees listed in this document are for the spring session only and reflect the length and number of classes for each activity. One of the factors in determining the pricing for each class is the total number of class days. For clarity, the total numbers of class days on each weekday in the spring are as follows: Monday: 9; Tuesday: 10; Wednesday: 10; Thursday: 10; and Friday: 8. Additional class supply fees are already calculated, unless otherwise noted in the class description. *Holidays and all school closings are already taken into account.*

Note: Based on feedback from our external after school providers and internal reflections on how we can better manage class lists and billing, we have decided not to offer a trial week for students. **No refunds or reductions will be given for classes missed due to a student's absence, due to inclement weather conditions, or closures beyond the School's control.**

Program Procedures

At the end of the school day, students participating in Extended Day Care (EDC), after school enrichment classes, or music lessons will remain in their classrooms until dismissal is finished. At the conclusion of dismissal, students who are registered for after school activities will go outside for recess, have their snack (which is brought from home), and then will proceed to their after school class or the Homework Center.

Private music lessons follow different time formats according to individual student needs and instructor availability. For more information, please contact: yannin.garcia@wis.edu.

Extended Day Care (EDC)

Extended Day Care begins on Monday, April 3, 2023 and will include structured ways for students to work on various skills while staying after school. For students in Grades 1-5, the Homework Center will provide a quiet place for them to complete their homework.

Students in Grades 1-5 will attend the Homework Center from 4:00-5:00 PM, Monday-Thursday, under the guidance of WIS teachers, who will provide homework and language support. The Homework Center provides a direct link between the school day and after school time.

Following homework time, students will participate in activities, including arts & crafts, games, sports, and team building. Students will learn good sportsmanship, teamwork, and leadership skills while having fun.

Preschool, Pre-Kindergarten, and Kindergarten students will meet in their respective classrooms with our EDC supervisors, who will lead reading, games, and other class activities.

The typical schedule for EDC is listed below:

Early Years: 3:00-6:00 PM Grades 1-5: 3:30-6:00 PM

Note: If your child(ren) is/are enrolled in an after school class, you do not need to enroll them in Extended Day Care for that day. Only enroll your child(ren) in Extended Day Care if they are not enrolled in an after school class on that specific day.

Siblings of Students Enrolled in After School Classes

For the 2022-2023 academic school year, if one student is enrolled in an after school class, but that student's sibling(s) is/are not, then the sibling not enrolled in the class can stay in Extended Day Care for no charge. This applies only to siblings of students enrolled in an after school class, not Extended Day Care.

Non-WIS Students & After School Programs

For the 2022-2023 academic school year, non-WIS students will not be able to attend the WIS after school program. Please contact the Co-Curricular Programs office if you have any questions or concerns.

Early Arrival Enrichment Program

For families that need to get to work earlier in the day, Co-Curricular Programs offers the Early Arrival Enrichment Program starting at 7:00 AM. Students enrolled in the Early Arrival Enrichment Program will participate in recreational activities such as yoga, pilates, and stretching to activate their concentration and attention in a fun manner. Students will learn basic exercise techniques that will strengthen their levels of flexibility and equilibrium, help them be more active, and prepare for classes. By 7:55 AM, the enrichment program winds down and students are led to different areas of the building where they join their classmates arriving at 8:00 AM.

Note: The Early Arrival Enrichment Program does not operate on Professional Days or days when parent-teacher conferences are scheduled for the Primary School. In the event of a delay due to inclement weather, the school will be open for early arrival at 9:00 AM for students who are already registered for the Early Arrival Enrichment Program.

After School Music Lessons for Spring 2023

To participate in music lessons for the 2022-2023 school year, all families must register students for available time slots with the instructor of their choice. Please use the online registration system to secure a day and time for instruction for your child. Instructional times at the Primary School between 3:30 PM and 4:30 PM are reserved for students in Pre-Kindergarten through Grade 2. Slots between 4:30 PM and 6:00 PM are open for students in Grades 3-5.

When students enroll in a lesson during the fall and/or winter terms, the slot for day and time will be kept for the spring term and there is no need to re-register. If families wish to disenroll or otherwise make a change in instructor, day, and/or time, we ask that you send an email message to yannin.garcia@wis.edu with "Spring Term Music Lesson Change" indicated in the subject header.

Once the term has begun, it is not possible to make any changes. Registration implies that children will continue lessons through the entire term.

After School Choir and Band

Enrollment for band and choir took place in the fall, and these classes continue until the spring. **Please confirm your child's reenrollment or**

disenrollment from these classes by emailing Yannin Garcia at yannin.garcia@wis.edu. While the choir program is full, there are still spots available in the band. If you would like to enroll your child in band (Beginner Brass/Percussion, Beginner Woodwind, or Advanced Ensemble), please contact Yannin Garcia as well.

Registration Procedures

To register for spring after school classes, please follow the instructions below.

LOGGING IN

Go to https://wisafterschool.campbrainregistration.com/

You have the option to log in with your WIS on Campus account — click "Login Using on Campus." Using on Campus has two benefits: 1) There is no need to create another username and password, and 2) Your child's and household's information will automatically be filled in on the registration forms.

If you are new to WIS or do not remember your onCampus password, click "Login using onCampus," fill in your username (email address) and click "Forgot your login?" Follow the steps and check your email for a link to set your password.

If you'd prefer not to log in with onCampus, you may use the alternate sign-in option or fill in the new user sign-up.

REGISTERING FOR CLASSES

Once logged in, click on "Start Application" under the 2023 Spring After School Classes to begin. Then click "Continue" and follow these steps:

Step 1 (Select Child for Registration): Mark the checkbox next to the name of the child you would like to register and select the grade. Click "Continue."

Step 2 (Select Sessions): Here, you will see a list of After School class options. You can click on 'Filter" to sort the classes by a specific day. Music classes are listed separately from the rest of the classes. You can also search for classes by name in the search box. Select a session, then click "Add to Cart." Make sure to select extended day or shuttle options (listed below the class name) if needed. Review your Cart on the right and then click "Continue."

Step 3 (Fill out Forms): Click on your Household Form. Review your family's information. Important: if you make changes that you want reflected in your family's school record, email updates@wis.edu. You must enter at least one emergency contact. Click "Complete this Form." Once the form closes, click "Continue."

Step 4 (Payment): Your student account will be billed for all After School classes. Please review this page and click "Continue" to confirm you agree to this charge.

Step 5 (Review and Submit): Review your selections under "Registration items." If you need to make changes, click "Add/remove Sessions" or "Add/remove People" and then follow the steps outlined above again. When you are ready, click "Submit Registration."

Step 6 (Confirmation page): For successful registrations, you'll see this message, with a summary of your selections: "Thank you for submitting your application. Your class(es) has been confirmed." If you can't register your

child(ren) because the class is full, please send an email to yannin.garcia@wis.edu so that they can be added to a waiting list.

One of the most popular after school activities at WIS, chess is also one of the world's most popular games, played by millions of people across the globe.

BEGINNER: This class is meant for beginners who don't know how to play chess. Students will learn the rules of chess, including piece movement, check, checkmate, and stalemate, followed by basic endgames checkmates, basic opening principles, piece values, and more! Class time is divided between lessons and practice games.

BEYOND BEGINNER: This class is meant for students who can confidently play a game of chess on their own, but don't have too much experience. Students will learn (or review) basic endgames, checkmates, basic opening principles, and piece values before getting into tactics like forks, pins, and skewers. Class time is divided between lessons and practice games.

INTERMEDIATE/ADVANCED: This class is meant for intermediate and advanced students with over a year of experience who are building toward or already playing in tournaments. Students will work on tactics, calculation, openings, and endgames. Lessons are across a variety of themes, and will be new each semester so that returning students can continue to progress.
