XII. BOARD DISCUSSION

Governance Committee Comments– Mrs. Napolitano advised the committee discussed the abolishment of two Board of Education policies and reviewed several other policies. 1. The Board of Education of Sayreville approved the list of bills dated February 7, 2023, prepared by the Board Secretary in the amount of \$429,721.25 for the Operating Account.

2. The Board of Education of Sayreville approved the acceptance of a donation of an interactive whiteboard depicting a basketball court valued at \$1,400.00 from Touchboards.com for the gymnasium at Wilson School. It will be utilized as a visual resource for explaining lessons, games, and activities.

3. The Board of Education of Sayreville approved the acceptance of the 2022-2023 Middle Grades Career Exploration Grant in the amount of \$68,500. This is the second year of the three-year competitive grant program designed to cultivate the development of career awareness and exploration programs focused on engaging instruction and unique experiences for students in the middle grades.
