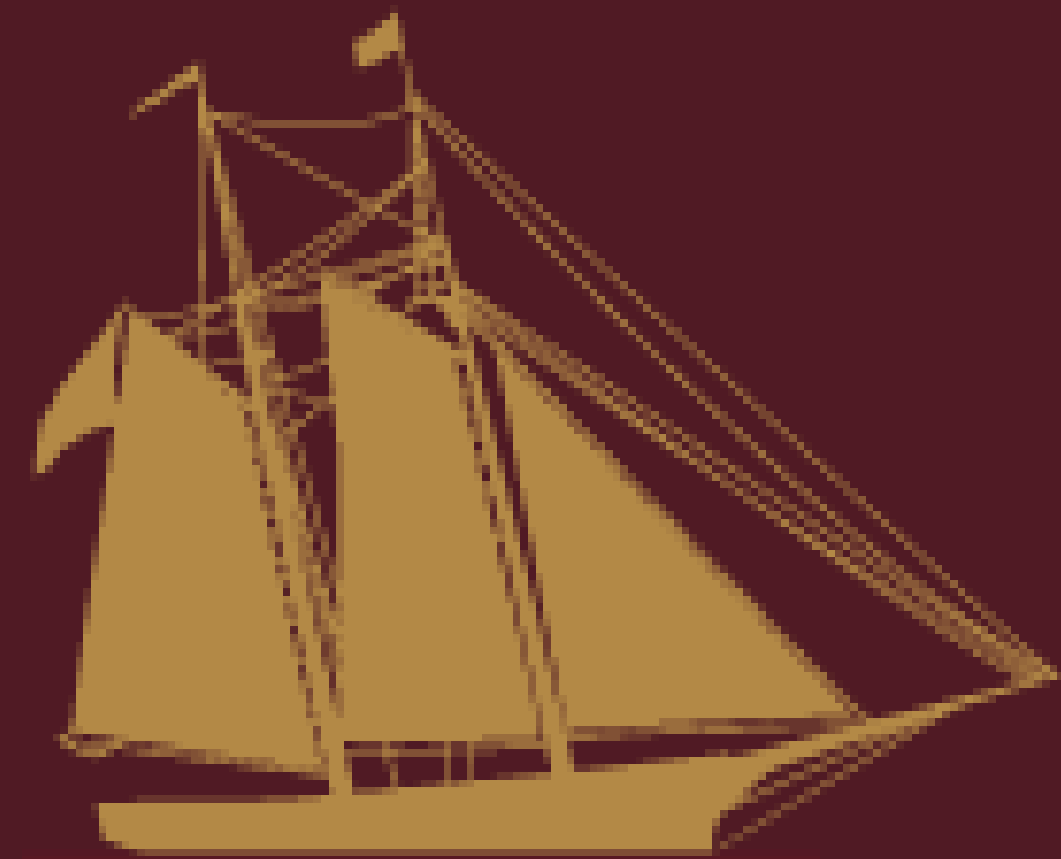

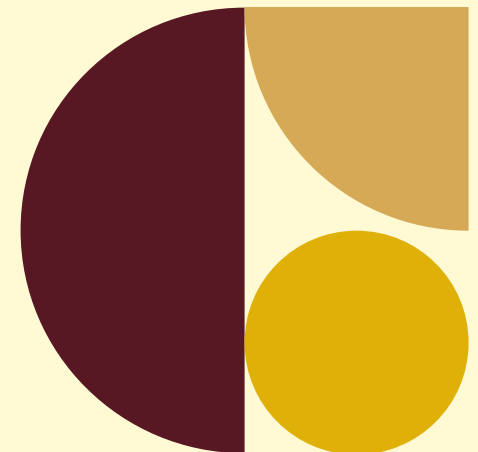

School offers opportunities to build relationships and develop skills such as listening, paying attention, problem-solving and self-regulation, all which are needed to grow and learn.



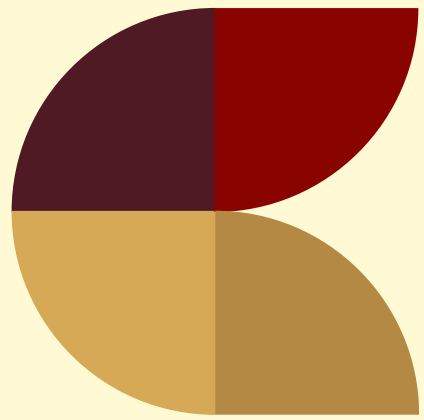
