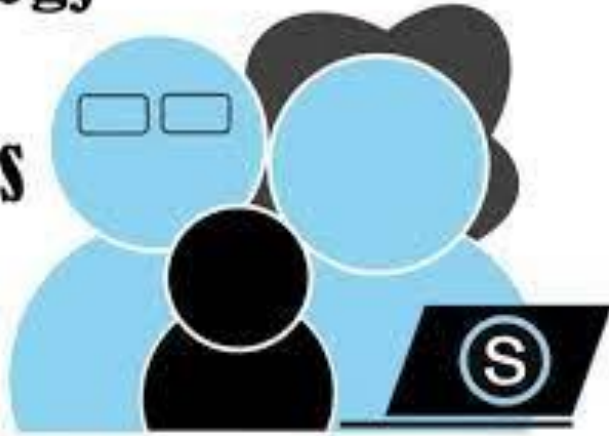


Schoology for Parents



A guide for CCCS Parents to access their child's grade information on Schoology.

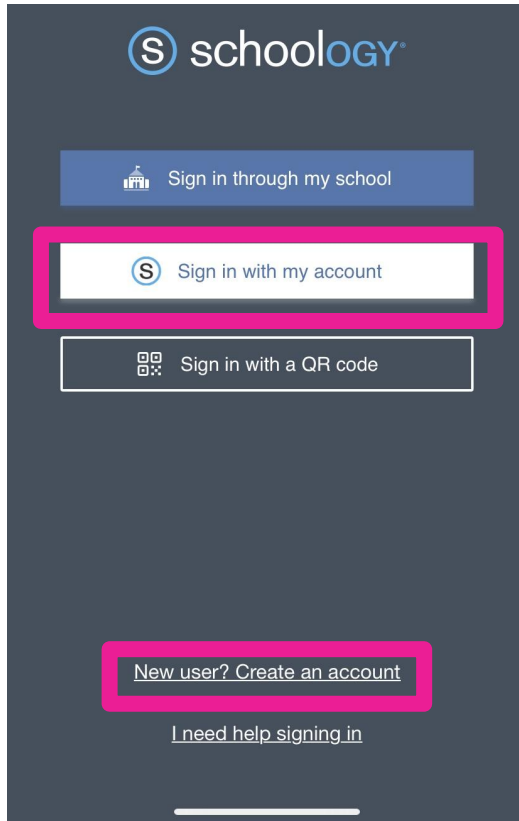
First Steps

1. Go to your App Store
2. Search Schoology
3. Select and download. No cost!
4. Once downloaded, open app



Getting Into the Schoology App

1. If you have Schoology login information, please sign in using your account.
2. If you've never used Schoology before, you will need to Create an Account by clicking on the link at the bottom of the app.


New Users Notes: You will be asked to if you want to Register with Schoology Canada. Choose No, and continue following the dialog box.

Enter your Access Code



After you have set up your account, you will be able to add more children if needed. We will show how after we have finished with the first student access code.



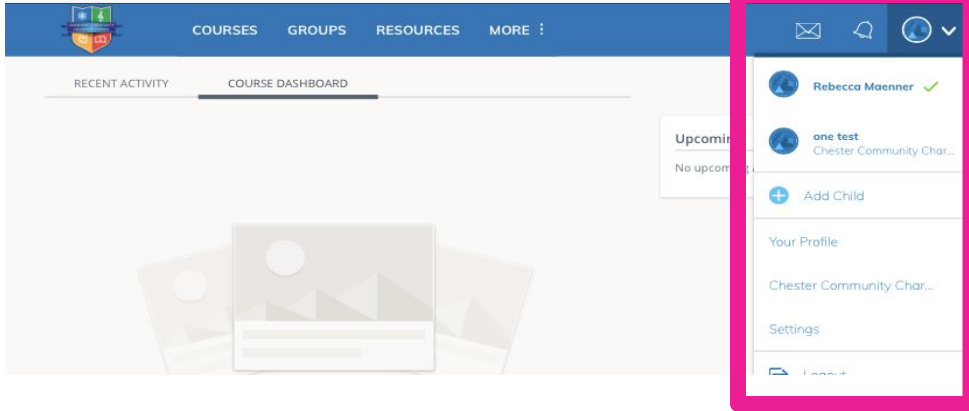
You will see your name and your student(s) names below yours. Please click your students name.

What can I see in Schoology with my parent account?

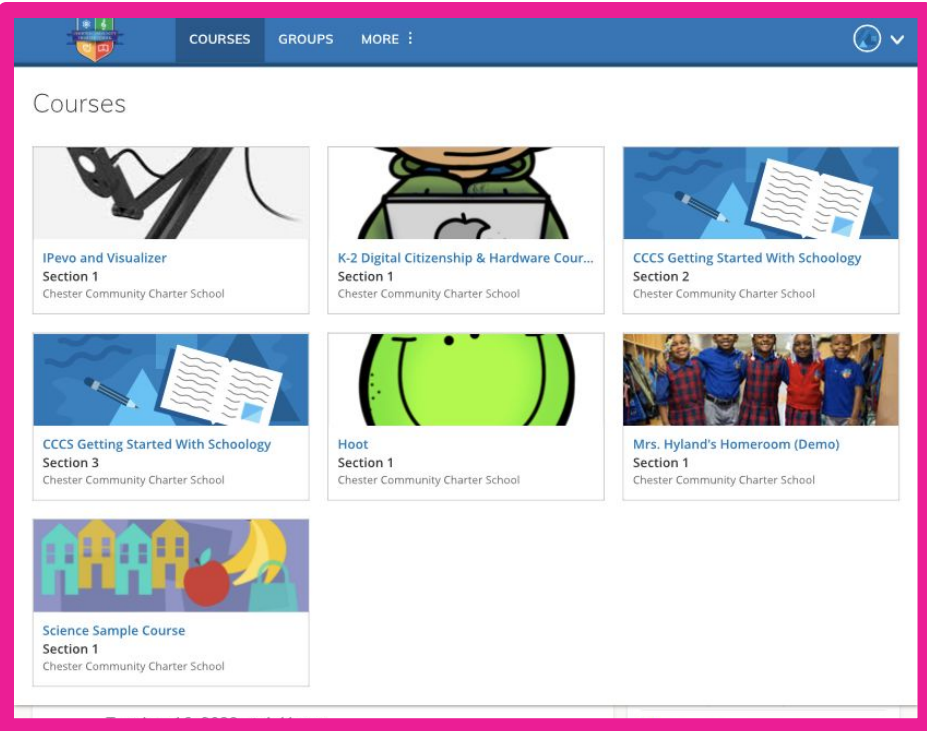
There are specific modules available to parents, including course updates, course content, and each student's assignment calendar. Parents cannot review submitted assignments, feedback from teachers, or grades in Schoology. Grades and attendance can be viewed in the Sapphire Parent Portal.

The **Calendar** shows an aggregation of a student's assignments in all courses. Parents can use the calendar view to understand when assignments are due, and how coursework is dispersed throughout a particular marking period.

The **Course** tab reveals all courses in which a student is enrolled. Parents can review course content posted by teachers, and even view assignments.



Seeing Your Student's Classes



At the top, you will see “Courses”.

If you hover over this, all the courses will show.

You can click any course to review work and grades.



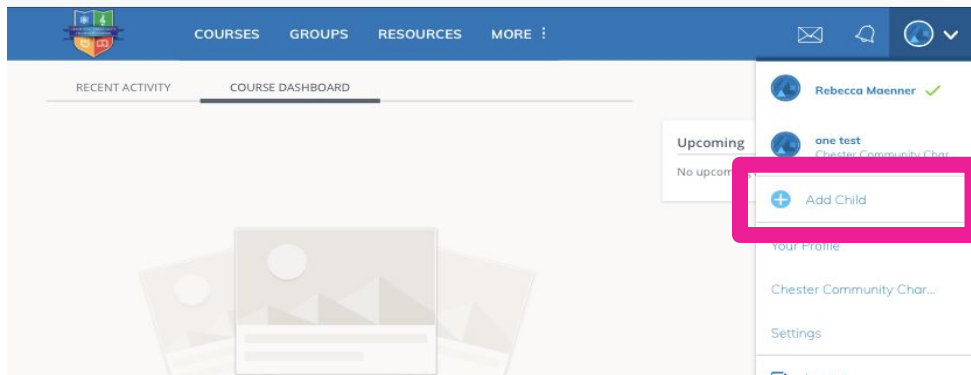

Adding Additional Children to Your Account



Add children to your Schoology Parent Account

If you already have a parent account in Schoology for one child, you can add additional children to your account. To add additional children, please follow these steps:

1. Log into your **Schoology** account using your username or email address and password.
2. Click on the downfacing arrow on the top right of the Schoology account.
3. Select the option to **+Add Child**.
4. Enter the Parent Access Code for the child you'd like to add to your account. Teachers will be sending the access codes to parents directly.
5. The code should look similar to 1A2E-B3C4-5KD6.
6. Click on the **Use Code** button to complete.
