

MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF  
DUPREE SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 64-2  
ZIEBACH COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA

The Board of Education of the Dupree School District No. 64-2 met in Special Session at the Dupree School on Monday, July 27, 2020 at 5 p.m. with President Longbrake presiding.

Members present: Jesse (Jake) Longbrake; Leo Bakeberg III, Jody Schrempp, Mandi Smith and Jess Brewer

Members absent: none

Others present: Gail Swenson, Superintendent; Connie Alspach, Business Manager; Cindy Lindskov, Elementary Principal; Russ Budmayr, High School Principal and members from the community.

All motions were passed by unanimous vote unless stated otherwise.  
27-21-Motion by Bakeberg, second by Schrempp to approve the agenda as presented with the addition of CRST Health Task Force Presentation.

Supt. Swenson presented the 2020-21 School Year COVID-19 Reopening Plan. The following plans were presented: Plan A – Traditional Normal Operation (On-Site); Plan A.2 – Modified Modification to Operations (medically fragile/special needs students remote instruction); Plan B – Hybrid Operations (combination of on-site & remote instruction - packets and online); Plan C – FLEX Remote Operations (remote instruction; packets and online for all). Mitigation strategies were also presented and reviewed (instruction, facilities, transportation, food service, building restrictions, activities, operations, staff training, communication, and staff illness).

A demonstration was given by teachers; Brittany Brooks and Kathy Olsen on how the online teaching instruction (Google Classroom) will take place if Hybrid or Remote Operations were to be implemented.

CRST Public Health Task Force Guidance for Schools during the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency policy statement and guidelines was presented by Randolph Runs After.

Jesse Brewer entered meeting at 6 p.m.

The Public was given the opportunity to ask questions or comment on the information presented regarding the COVID-19 Reopening Plan. Discussion was held.

The Dupree School Task Force Committee and Administration recommended to the Dupree School Board that school begin August 20, 2020 on the Hybrid Plan B a combination of on-site and remote instruction for a limited time, discussion was held.
