We will use the Air Quality Index measured at [airnow.gov](http://airnow.gov). We have designated staff checking the site throughout the day on days where air quality is a concern. Following the [Sonoma County Guidelines](#) as provided to us by the Sonoma County Office of Education, the following will be our practice:

Air Quality Index (AQI) of 0-100 will be monitored and all activities can continue. (Green and Yellow)

AQI of 101-150 is unhealthy for sensitive groups (Orange)

- Students and staff with asthma are encouraged to stay indoors.
- Rigorous outdoor activities will be rescheduled or moved indoors
- Students may eat lunch outdoors
- Air filtration is on

AQI of 151-200 is unhealthy (Red)

- Students and staff will stay indoors
- Air filtration is on
- All outdoor athletic activities will be cancelled
- Students will eat indoors - Spaced apart as much as possible

AQI of 201 or higher is Very Unhealthy (Purple)

- ALL activities will be indoors
- Students will eat indoors - Spaced apart as much as possible
- Air filtration is on
- District will consider if any school closures are necessary
