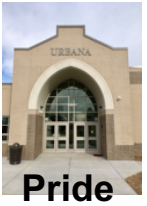

ACT and ASVAB TESTING

On Tuesday, February 28, 2023, Sophomores and Juniors will participate in required group testing. The **Sophomore** class will be taking the ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery). This is a FREE, NO STAKES test that will allow your student to identify their interests through a comprehensive Interest Inventory and then participate in a skills test that will cross-reference with their interests to indicate careers in which they would be successful (skills) and enjoy (interests). NO MILITARY RECRUITMENT WILL OCCUR! All **Juniors** will participate in the state offered FREE administration of the ACT (American College Test). ACT is a standardized test used for college admissions in the United States. The ACT test covers four academic skill areas: English, mathematics, reading and scientific reasoning. Scores are reported to colleges and universities when applying for admission. High scores can also influence/contribute to scholarship monies and/or reduced tuition at many state and private colleges. Please do not hesitate to contact your student's counselor if you have any questions or concerns. With a signed parent permission form on file, **Sophomore** and **Junior** students will be permitted to be excused when all testing is completed around midday. **Freshmen** and **Seniors** will NOT report to school on this date.

CCP

If your student is interested in taking College Credit Plus courses next year, a parent/guardian and the student need to attend a CCP Presentation and submit an intent form by April 1, 2023. Completing this information does not commit your student to anything, but per ODE rules, they cannot participate in College Credit Plus if the steps are not completed. Please be aware that this is required each year to be able to participate, including taking CCP courses at Urbana High School. ILLNESS AT SCHOOL

Any student who is too ill to attend class MUST contact the main office. Unless authorized by the school nurse or main office staff, students may not leave the building or school grounds due to illness or for any other reasons. Students leaving without authorization will be considered unexcused/truant. Absences from individual classes due to illness will be recorded for attendance purposes and students are not permitted to attend or participate in after school activities, athletic practices or events. PARENT ACCESS

REMIND

When you download the app, push notifications are turned on, and your text and email Remind messages are automatically disabled - so you do not receive duplicate notifications. You can control your notification preferences by clicking your name, choose "Account Settings" and then "Notification Preferences." From there you will be able to enable text messages, email messages, etc. It is also important to sign in to the app using your cell phone number and not an email address. Signing in with an email often creates a new account for the user which will not be linked properly to a student.
