

**BOARD OF DIRECTORS**Oath of Office

In accordance with statutory provision, new Directors, before entering upon the discharge of the duties thereof, shall take an oath of office to support the constitution of the United States and the State of Washington and to promote the interests of education, and to faithfully discharge the duties of office according to the best of their ability.

In case any officials have a written appointment or commission, their oath or affirmation shall be endorsed thereon and sworn to before any officer authorized to administer oaths. School officials are authorized to administer all oaths or affirmations pertaining to their respective offices. A school district officer or notary public must certify to this oath and the signature of the member and must file three (3) copies of the signed oath of office with the Educational Service District Superintendent, who shall forward copies to the county auditor and the State Superintendent of Public Instruction.
