The lessons in this unit emphasized speaking up for themselves and others, using kind words, and working together.

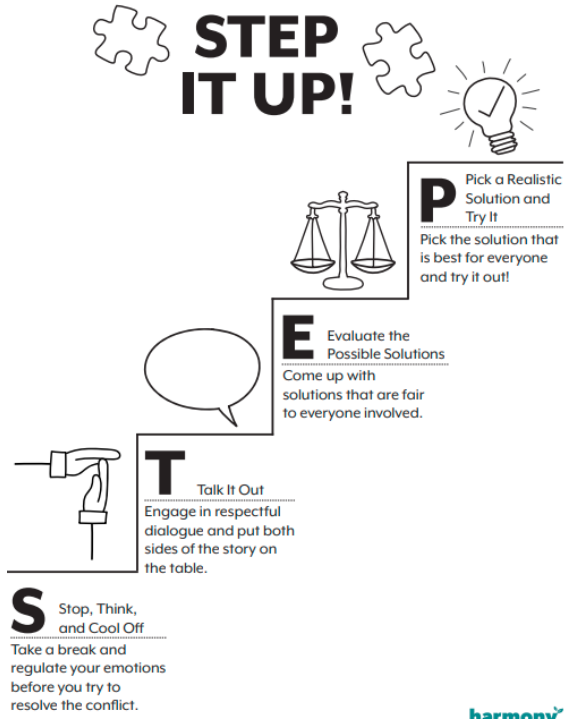
Students practiced scenarios using kind, assertive speaking skills to make sure their needs and ideas are being heard. T Here are a few questions you can ask your students to see what they learned from the activities.

When do you feel most comfortable speaking up? When do you feel least comfortable? What can you do to feel more comfortable in that situation?

We played games to learn communication boosters and communication bloopers. They learned five tools, or boosters to help them communicate as a team in order to meet a goal: listening, supporting, negotiating, facilitating, and responding.

They thought about which booster would work best for different situations, and which one they thought they needed the most practice with. These are skills students and adults can use to communicate with team members/co-worker to be successful.

When we interact with others, problems and conflict are normal. Solving problems together is an important part of the process. These are the four steps to problem solving that we learned together.
