

## **Mississippi CDL Permit Information**

There are three parts to the Class A CDL learner's permit exam: General Knowledge, Air Brakes, and Combination Vehicles. All three parts of the exam will be taken at your local DMV office.

You must have your DOT physical in hand before a CDL learner's permit will be issued, even if you have passed all written tests. The DMV will **NOT** issue a CDL learner's permit without the medical information. The medical information is attached to your permit\CDL per federal regulations.

CDL learner's permits can only be renewed once before you will have to retest. Permits must be valid throughout the duration of the program.
