Free Breakfast and Free Lunch Notice

Effective Wednesday, March 1, Suffield Public Schools will again be providing free breakfast and free lunch for all students. There will be no charge for breakfast or lunch for students from March 1 through the end of the 2022-23 school year.

Students who owe funds for meals received since December 1, 2022 will still be responsible for paying those balances.

Please note the following:

- Only one breakfast and one lunch is free for each student. Additional meals will be at the regular price of \$2.10 for breakfast and \$3.00 for lunch at Spaulding and McAlister schools and \$3.25 or \$3.50 for the middle and high schools.
- A la carte items will still be available for purchase. Please note the following revised prices for these items:
 - Snacks (Chips, Rice Krispie Bars, etc.) \$ 1.00
 - Cookies \$ 0.50
 - Ice Cream \$ 1.25
