- Only seniors that will graduate in 2021 may apply.
- Students must be planning on majoring in an agriculture related field.
- Preference will be given to students who are attending the University of Georgia, Abraham Baldwin Agricultural College, or North Georgia Technical College.
- The scholarship will be awarded once proof of enrollment at a post-secondary institution is received.
