Helps people in Braga, north of Portugal, build or improve a place they can call home. Works in partnership w/ Fuller Center for Housing (formerly it used to partner w/ Habitat for Humanity).



In 2018-2019, 3 teams of CAISL Juniors and Seniors worked on this rebuilding project.

- Provides services that satisfy the basic needs and psychosocial support of elderly people;
- Contributes to stabilize or slow down the ageing process;
- Develops conditions that preserve and motivate elderly people's usual life environment.

Partnership since: 2006 – CSC bi-monthly visits to play domino & cards interrupted in March 2020 due to COVID-19 – currently in the process of reiteration.

- Mental illness.

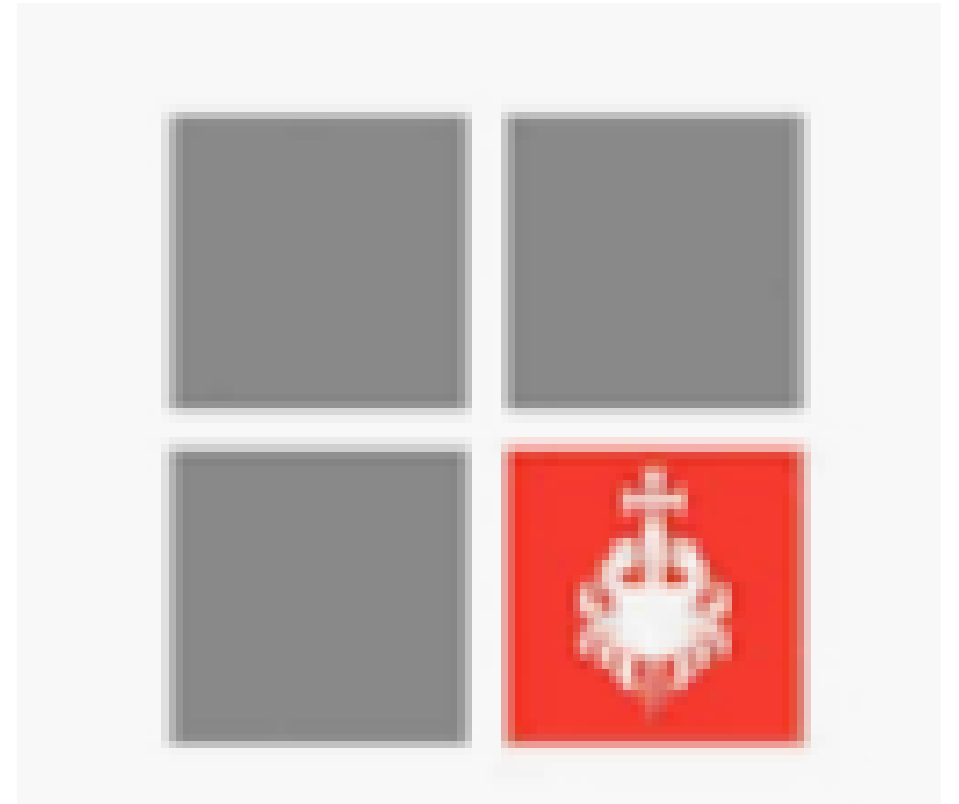

## OUR MISSION

To integrate and protect the lives of migrants and refugees in the city of Lisbon.

1. To provide clear information about existing (basic) services in lisbon.
2. To facilitate access to basic services by providing assistance through mediation.
3. To simplify legalisation processes by providing translation services.
4. To defend migrants' rights by providing free or low cost legal support.
5. To equip migrants with the local language through Portuguese language courses.
6. To accelerate children's integration in portuguese schools by providing extra-curricular tutoring.
7. To care for migrants by providing free or low cost health care assistance.
8. To empower migrants helping them find adequate and fair employment.
9. To build greater social cohesion between migrants and the local community.
10. To advocate for migrants' rights through workshops, blogs and social media.

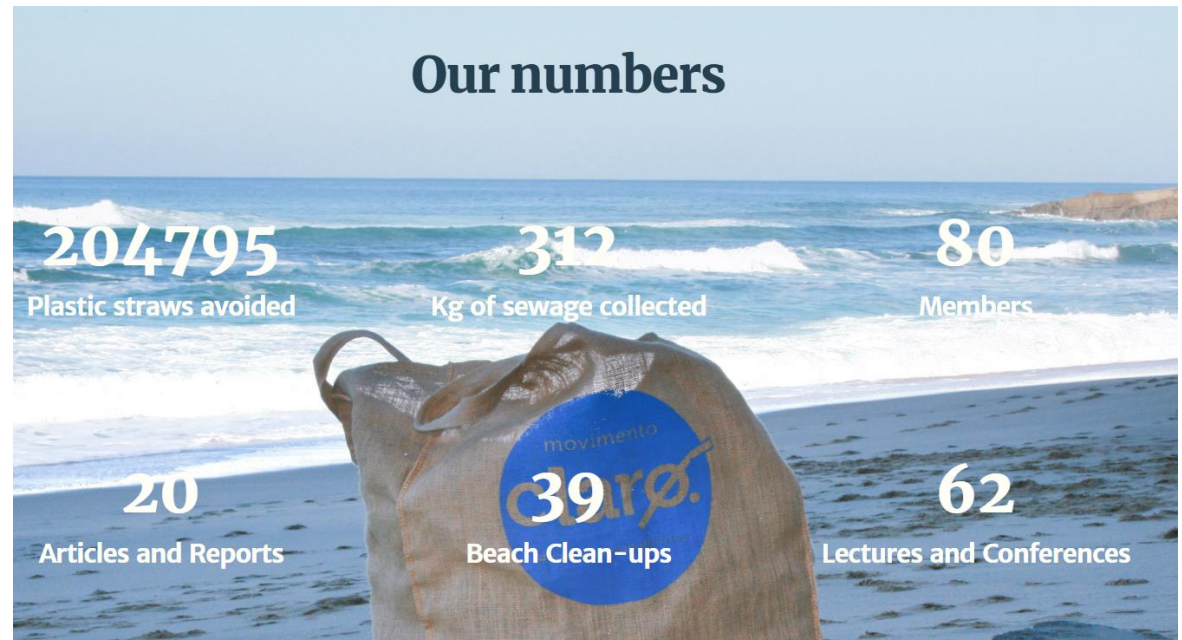
