The Troup County Board of Education is seeking bids for replacing two existing Sonicwall SuperMassive 9800 through E-Rate funding.

There are two data centers where the firewalls will be installed, and any quoted firewall must be able to operate in a clustered or Active/Active environment and have a single point of administration with a shared config. Combined, the firewalls must be able to sustain a minimum of 18 Gbit of Internet traffic at any given time. Firewalls must be of the NGFW class and equivalent or better than a Fortinet 600F or SonicWALL Supermassive E10400. Each firewall must have a minimum of 6 - 10Gb SFP+ or 4 - 10Gb SFP+ and 2 25Gb SFP+ ports. Quote must include necessary licenses for Gateway AV, Anti-Spyware, IPS, 24x7 support, hardware warranty, and any other necessary licenses for 5 years.

All proposals are due via email by March 17th, 2023, at 11:00 a.m.
