## **PARENTS: REMINDER OF OUR MEAL CHARGE POLICY**

The goal of Louisville City Schools Nutritional Services Department is first and foremost to provide healthy and nutritious meals to our students so they can better function and learn at school. As a self-sustaining enterprise fund, we must generate funds through student and adult meal sales, snack sales, and federal and state reimbursements in order to pay all operating expenses.

**When lunch money is forgotten, we have established the following procedures to:**

- **Treat all students with dignity and respect;**
- **Encourage parents to assume the responsibility of meal payments and to promote self-responsibility of the students;**
- **Establish consistent department procedure regarding charges.**

### Meal Charge Procedure

1. Student has a negative \$5.00 balance in their meal account
  - a. An automated email/phone call is generated.
  - b. Student can continue to charge meals only. No a la carte purchases when negative.
2. Student charges over \$15.00, generates use of "Full Belly" funds.
  - a. Every effort is made to contact parent / Guardians to:
    - i. Offer assistance with a meal application,
    - ii. Determine if there are other issues within the household that have caused the child to have insufficient funds to purchase a school meal and offer any other assistance that is appropriate.
    - iii. **If no assistance is necessary, it is the parent's responsibility to pay all meals charges incurred.**
  - b. **If, at the end of the school year, there is a remaining negative balance, this amount will remain as a fee with the student and will need to be paid before the student can transfer records or graduate.**
