successful “Top Off the Tahoe” in support of the Deer Park Schools holiday food drive. Thank you for helping us provide to DP families who are in need this holiday season.



WHEREAS, the school board sets policies and procedures to govern all aspects of school district operation; and


WHEREAS, the school board keeps attention focused on progress toward the school district's goals and maintains a two-way communications loop with all segments of the community; and
