HHIMS Mission Statement

Middle Years Programme

All students enrolled and attending Hilton Head Island Middle School and/or Hilton Head Island High School for grades 6th - 10th are considered academic scholars in the Middle Years Programme. For those students with accommodation plans such as an IEP, 504, and/or ILAP, appropriate modifications to the MYP framework will be made. There are no admission requirements as long as the student is registered and enrolled in either school.

Diploma Programme

The Diploma Programme is a programme of choice at HHIHS for students entering grade 11. We do not require any specific qualifications or stipulations in order for a student to begin the IB Diploma Programme.

However, each year our students are required to participate in an Individual Graduation Plan (IGP) meeting with a certified school counselor and the student's parent(s). In the 10th grade IGP meeting, the counselor reviews the student's historical academic record and plans for the last two years of high school and post-graduation. If it is appropriate and/or the student shows interest in the IBDP option, the counselor will plot out the courses needed for IBDP completion in grades 11 and 12. The coordinator will review the course of study.

Policy Review Process

This policy is reviewed annually and was last reviewed by each respective school's leadership and staff in the Spring of 2022. Additionally, each school had the policy reviewed by their PTSO/PTA and SIC in the Fall of 2022. During each review, participants spent time reading and discussing the policy then offered their feedback regarding the policy.
