Absentee Ballot Applications

Applications for absentee ballots are available in the District Office, which is located on the EHS campus. (If an absentee ballot is to be mailed to the voter, the application for the absentee ballot must be received in the District Office by 5 p.m. on Tuesday, May 9, 2023. If the absentee ballot is to be handed to the voter herself/himself, the ballot must be picked up no later than 5 p.m. on Monday, May 15, 2023. All executed absentee ballots must be received in the District Office no later than 5 p.m. on Tuesday, May 16, 2023.)

May 8, 2023

Voter Registration, District Office (EHS Campus),
3 p.m. – 7 p.m.

All residents who wish to vote in the May 16, 2023 budget vote and election of Board members must be registered in advance. To accommodate Edgemont residents who meet the State-mandated eligibility requirements as listed below, the District will hold voter registration on May 8, 2023. Proof of residency and proof of date of birth are required for in-person registration. Residents of Edgemont who wish to register at other dates/times must do so by going to the Westchester County Board of Elections, 25 Quarropas Street in White Plains or call 914-995-5700.

Voter Qualifications

To vote in the school's May 16, 2023 election, a resident must be:

- A citizen of the United States;
- At least eighteen years of age by May 16, 2023; and,
- A resident of the District for at least thirty days before May 16, 2023.
