TIMELINE



1854 Steilacoom School District No. 1 established.

1890 Pioneer block purchased from Mrs. Catherine Rogers.

1892 Second public school in Steilacoom built at Chambers & Sequalish streets.

1858 First public school in Steilacoom built at Starling & Frederick streets.

1885 Public school sessions moved to County Courthouse on Martin Street. Second DuPont school built at Mounts Prairie.

1917 Third public school in Steilacoom built at Chambers & Sequalish streets, replacing existing school building.

1968 Addition made to Pioneer School (former Steilacoom School).

1975 Approval of consolidation of Anderson Island, DuPont and Steilacoom School districts and renamed Steilacoom Historical School District No. 1.

1962 Cherrydale Primary School opened at Galloway and C streets, Steilacoom, serving students grade K - 4.

1972 Saltar's Point Elementary opened at Third and Beech Street, Steilacoom.

1999 Cherrydale and Saltar's Point schools remodeled with additional facilities and classrooms.

2001 Chloe Clark Elementary dedicated and opened to grades K - 4.

1981 Steilacoom High School completed and dedicated, creating a K - 12 district.

2000 Construction began on Chloe Clark Elementary, DuPont.

2003 Boundary dispute settled with Clover Park School District; changeover effective January 2010.

2006 Construction on Pioneer Middle School, Dupont and second phase of Chloe Clark Elementary began.

2007 Dedication of Anderson Island Elementary multi-purpose building.

2009 Steilacoom High renovated with new classrooms and modernized sports stadium.

2010 Harriet Taylor Elementary closed due to downsizing of McNeil Island Corrections Center.

2008 Pioneer Middle, Steilacoom closed and Pioneer Middle, DuPont opened.

2013 Saltar's Point Elementary added two new classrooms.

2017 District celebrated Old Pioneer Middle School's 100th Anniversary.

2014 Pioneer Middle, Steilacoom remodeled into District Administration Center.
