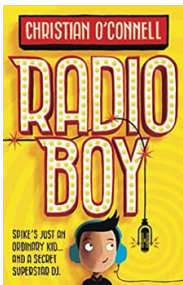

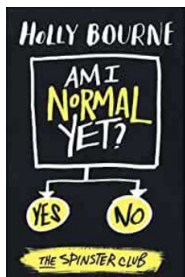
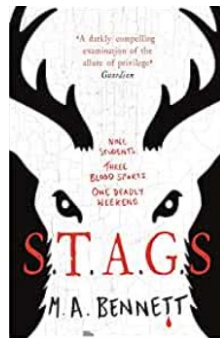


Your favourites from the library:



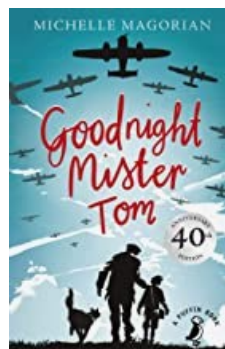
"It was very funny and the characters were very relatable. I like how Spike (the protagonist) learns what's more important, the radio show or his friends." RW Year 7
