Alumni will be eligible for consideration at least 10 years after their year of graduation
They can be nominated for any of the following reasons:

- Leader in their field
- Academic Honors
- Notable Accomplishments

Nomination process

To nominate a candidate:

Submit 2 letters of recommendation (from yourself and another person)

Provide a list of positions held and honors the nominee has received. You may do so in a resume form or add any additional information

Write a 500 word (max) essay to the selection committee stating why the nominee is worthy of this award

Nominations will be accepted year round at the high school and can be mailed or emailed to the high school administration emusic@mybvls.org Nominations provided before May 31 will be considered in that school year. The selection committee will meet once a year to make a determination and the honor will be presented at the Hall of Fame Ceremony Nominations will be active for 3 years after submission.

The selection committee will be made up of 5 current or retired teachers who taught in the Buckeye Valley Local School district (or predecessor district) for a minimum of three years. There will be a committee chair.
