

Bullying Report

2021-2022 School Year

This report was provided to the Alexander Local School District Board of Education at their regular meeting on August 10, 2022.

For the 2021-2022 school year, there were 2 incidents of bullying reported, involving 2 separate offenders. This information comes from our student information system.

The definition of bullying is the intentional use of aggressive words or actions toward the same person, repeated over time, that involves an imbalance of power. The major types of bullying include physical, verbal and relational. When technology is involved it is considered cyberbullying.

Administrators, Counselors, teachers and other staff work with students across all grade levels, in multiple different classes to identify, understand and become proactive against bullying.

October is National Bullying Prevention Month and our students and staff participate in various events to focus and raise awareness on bullying.
