


# ACADEMIC MICIP GOALS

**NWEA-** 50% or more of our students will meet their NWEA GOALS fall to spring targets in both reading and math

**M-Step/PSAT-** proficiency will increase in both ELA and Math by 15% for grades 3-11

**Attendance Goals-** Average daily attendance will be at 95% by June 2023; Chronic absenteeism will decrease by 15% in comparison to the 2021-2022 school year

is a pathway for districts to improve student outcomes by assessing whole child needs to develop plans and coordinate funding.


# DATA NORMS PYRAMID




Fall 2022/2023 - Widely Held Expectations




# Snap Shot: Based on Kindergarten Readiness

Fall - Kindergarten Readiness




