INTRO & LINK

- Your children may be eligible for a college scholarship Indiana's 21st Century Scholars program offers income-eligible Hoosier students up to four years of paid tuition at an eligible Indiana college or university after they graduate from high school, dependent upon financial need.
- In middle and high school, Scholars are connected to programs and resources to help them stay on track for college and career success. Once in college, Scholars receive support to complete their college degrees and connect to career opportunities.
- 7th and 8th grade Indiana students whose families meet income eligibility guidelines can apply to become a 21st Century Scholar. Applications must be received by June 30 of the student's 8th grade year.

STEP ONE: ENROLL

- **Purple tab at the top of the page that says "21st Century Scholars"**
- **Options appear under it, then click "How to Enroll", all the way to the bottom for information in Spanish.**
- **This page has all the requirements and a button, "Enroll"**
- **This takes you over to Scholar Track where you will create an account.**



- Student's Social Security Number, date of birth and address.
- Parent or guardian's Social Security Number or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number, if applicable.
- 2021 gross income amounts for all members of the household. If applying after December 31, 2022, use 2022 gross income.
- A valid email address (free email accounts are available at Yahoo.com, Gmail.com, Hotmail.com, and Live.com).

REQUIREMENTS

1. BE A RESIDENT OF INDIANA

- Be a resident of Indiana both when applying and when receiving the scholarship (determined by the residency of the parent or legal guardian).

2. BE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- U.S. citizen or U.S. national (includes natives of American Samoa or Swains Island)
- U.S. permanent resident who has an I-151, I-551 or I-551C (Alien Registration Receipt Card)
- A [non-citizen](#) with one of the following designations ([Un no ciudadano](#) con cualquier de las designaciones que siguen):
 - Refugee
 - Asylum Granted
 - Indefinite Parole and/or Humanitarian Parole
 - Cuban-Haitian Entrant, Status Pending

3. BE ENROLLED IN THE 7TH- OR 8TH-GRADE YEAR

- Be enrolled in the 7th- or 8th-grade year at an Indiana public or private school accredited by the Indiana Department of Education.
- Children in foster care may apply after the 8th-grade year.
- Homeschooled students are not eligible for the 21st Century Scholars program.

4. MEET THE INCOME ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES.

- See chart (next slide) for current income guidelines. Note: students must meet income eligibility guidelines at time of enrollment and each year of college.
- A student in foster care does not need to meet this requirement.
- A student in 7th or 8th-grade year who is in legal guardianship does not need to meet this requirement.
