Instructions for 8th Grade 2023-24 Registration Card

ACADEMIC COURSES: Every student will be assigned four academic classes. The classes are Language Arts, Science, US History, and Math. Students will be placed in the appropriate math class according to their current math placement. **If you believe this is not the best math course placement, please contact your current math teacher.*

WORLD LANGUAGE – Students have the opportunity to take a World Language class in 7th grade, however, it is not a required elective in 8th grade. Students who successfully complete a Level 1 language course in 8th grade can take the Level 2 course in high school. Students having successfully completed the Level 1 language course in 7th grade can take the Level 2 of that language in 8th grade. Students receive a high school credit for passing this course, therefore, the workload, pacing and expectations reflect the norms of a high school level language course. **The grade they receive in this course will be on the high school transcript that goes to colleges. It will not, however, be factored into the high school grade point average (GPA).**

ELECTIVE COURSES – The Elective classes will complete a student's schedule. **Students will take 2 full-year electives OR 1 full-year elective and 2 semester electives, OR 4 semester electives.** Please note that students choosing 4 electives cannot be guaranteed their top choices and may be placed in alternative choices based on availability.

If your first choice is a full year elective- World Language, Band or Choir. Please rank the order of the choice of your World Language elective (1-4) or mark an "X" next to the choice for a music class.

If a student chooses **2 full-year electives**, they have completed their elective choices.

If not choosing 2 full-year electives, the 20-week elective classes must be ranked in order of preference. Every effort will be made to give students their top choices.

**Band 8 or Orchestra 8 should only be selected if it was taken in 7th grade or special arrangements have been made through the Band teacher.*

2. Fill out the registration card completely.
3. Include your signature at the bottom of the registration card.

1. Sign the bottom of the registration card.
