



Penn State is in the top 1 percent of universities worldwide and has the largest alumni network in the nation. Founded in 1855, the University combines academic rigor with a vibrant campus life as it carries out its mission of teaching, research, and service with pride and focuses on the future throughout Pennsylvania and the world. Granted the highest rating for research universities by the Carnegie Foundation, Penn State teaches students to be leaders with a global perspective.

Penn State has 20 campuses spread throughout the state. The main campus, Penn State University Park, is located in the small city of State College, a quintessential college town with its small eateries and quirky shops that line the street marking the border between downtown and campus. Nestled near the base of Mount Nittany, the surrounding area of central Pennsylvania is known as "Happy Valley."

Penn State enrolls about 75,000 stduents who study in programs offered through the Colleges of Agriculture, Arts and Architecture, Business Administration, Communications, Earth and Mineral Sciences, Education, Engineering, Health and Human Development, Liberal Arts, and Science.

Scholarships.com - Divides scholarships by a variety of unique categories, including GPA, military affiliation, ethnicity, artistic ability, ACT or SAT score and residing state.

College Board - Students can filter awards by interests, field of study, club affiliations or specific situations, like if parents are divorced.

Going Merry - Lets students type in information once and apply for multiple scholarships at the same time.

Scholarship Owl - Compiles awards and organizes them by amount, types requirements, number of winners and length of time until the application is due.
