*Memorial Scholarship*

The **Lynn M. Enberg Memorial Scholarship** has been established in loving memory of her contributions to the lives of her students. Mrs. Lynn M. Enberg completed her Degree in Education from Bemidji State University in 1972 and was a Teacher of Elementary and Middle School at Pillager Public School for 40 years from 1972 – 2012. Although retired she continued to have contact with her friends and colleagues and remained concerned with the welfare of student and her school until her death in April of 2020.

Lynn loved her students. She greatly enjoyed seeing young minds develop and progress. She was a mentor and trusted counselor of younger Teachers starting out in the education field and attempting to establish their careers, to honor her memory the Lynn M. Enberg Memorial Scholarship was conceived.

### ***Lynn M. Enberg Memorial Scholarship***

The Enberg family, through the Freshwater Education District, has established the Lynn M. Enberg Memorial Scholarship Fund to promote the Education and Medical Fields among deserving students. The amount of the Lynn M. Enberg Memorial Award will come from direct payment from her family and be paid to the student selected at graduation.

*The amount of this scholarship is \$1,500.00.*

The scholarship award is to be based on the following criteria:

1. The award shall be granted to a graduating senior from Pillager Public High School who plans a career in the Education or Medical field.
2. It may be used to attend a vocational school, a science school, or a college.
3. The most important consideration shall be seriousness of purpose of a student in attaining a degree in Education or Medical field or vocational equivalent.
4. The other points to be considered are scholarship and service to their school and community.
5. Extra consideration should be given to children of Military retirees or children of Purple Heart recipients.

The committee that selects the scholarship winner will be chaired by Mrs. Gabrielle Schmidt and Independent Pillager School faculty past and present. The Enberg Family does not wish any involvement in selection and does not require to be notified what student is selected.

The application procedure will consist of attaching to this cover page a scholarship resume and a short essay, not to exceed one typewritten page, about the field of education or medical science that you plan to enter.

## ***Student Application Instructions***

### Application Guidelines

You must use the official *Lynn M Enberg Memorial Scholarship Fund* application. It must be dated and signed by you and your parent(s)/guardian. Applications and all supporting documents must be in English.

### Honors and Awards

The following is a list to assist in completion of the Honors and Awards section, page 3. Include awards such as Eagle Scout; Gold Award; Teen of the Year: Statewide or National Conferences (ex: Boy's/Girl's State, HOBY); National Merit Finalist; AP Scholar; major athletic award; and major academic award. Do not include awards such as Academic/Athletic Letter; Honor Roll; Perfect Attendance; Scout Merit Badges; Teen of the Month; Top Percent of the Class; and Who's Who. This list is not inclusive. Activity sheets are acceptable replacements for the Employment and Community Service section and page 3, but must be structured identically to the application.

### Applicant Essay

You must prepare an essay of 500 words or less stating: the role educator has played in your development and why you wish to emulate them and/or medicine has played in your high school accomplishments, determining career aspirations, achieving your life goals, and preparing for college. The essay must be dated and signed.

High School/College Transcripts: A copy of all high school transcripts must be submitted with the application.

### Letter of Recommendation

Include one letter of recommendation from a high school teacher. The letter may cover your ability, work habits, leadership, personality, and integrity.

Include one letter of recommendation from a person who could be coach, mentor, or community member the person can be from your high school or from the community. The person should not be related to you. The letter may cover your participation in the community in terms of work service, demonstrated leadership ability and growth potential, and outstanding recognition.

Letters may be originals or photocopies and must be limited to one side of a single sheet (8.5 by 11 inch) of paper, typed, dated and signed by the author.
