Youth Mental Health First Aid

Hello Parents/Guardians of Falls Lake Academy: Do you want to learn how to better support our youth? Youth Mental Health First Aid is designed to provide information and tools for adults to recognize and support youth mental health. I am excited to be able to offer this certification training.

Youth Mental Health First Aid teaches you how to identify, understand and respond to signs of mental illness and substance use disorders in youth. This 7-hour training gives adults who work and or live with youth the skills they need to reach out and provide initial support to children and adolescents (ages 12-18) who may be developing a mental health or substance use problem and help connect them to the appropriate care. At the end of the course, participants will be a certified Youth Mental Health First Aider!

Generally there is a fee to participate in the training, however Falls Lake Academy is sponsoring all 20 participants. I, Amanda Moore, certified school counselor and Youth Mental Health First Aid certified instructor, will be the instructor for this course. The training will take place at Falls Lake Academy on March 18th, 2023. You will receive a confirmation email with your registration status and all necessary details regarding the day of training.
