**PURCHASE AND REPLACEMENT OF PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT AT WEST
MAPLE FUNDED BY WEST MAPLE'S FFE BUDGET THROUGH THE 2020 BOND**

(Recommended by: Interim Business Finance Manager)

MOVED:

- WHEREAS,** Birmingham Public Schools staff, students and parents developed a ten year facility plan identifying long term capital needs; and
- WHEREAS,** District voters supported the March 10, 2020, \$195 million bond proposal with 76% approval; and
- WHEREAS,** The principal of West Maple, Jason Pesamoska, in coordination with Set Seg our insurance provider, designated the existing spider web play structure as unsafe and a liability; and
- WHEREAS,** Staff members, students and the West Maple community discussed viable options for the replacement of the unsafe play structure; and
- WHEREAS,** The staff members, students and the West Maple community chose a new Elevate Fitness Course play structure to replace the unsafe playground spider web structure; and
- WHEREAS,** The new Elevate Fitness Course playground structure will be more inclusive for all students and community at West Maple; and
- WHEREAS,** The district maintains board approved consortium memberships through the US Communities Purchasing Cooperative, MiDeal, and Sourcewell, all of which retain contracts with playground equipment providers; and
- WHEREAS,** Based on thorough discussions, the district, staff members, students and the West Maple community recommends that the new Elevate Fitness Course playground structure be purchased through Snider Recreation, who is part of the board approved consortium membership;
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** That the Board of Education allow the purchase and replacement of a playground structure through the consortium contract pricing in an amount not to exceed a cost of \$103,323 to be funded by the West Maples FFE Budget through the 2020 Bond
