PURCHASE OF FURNITURE FROM CURRENT CONTRACTS FOR BOND PROJECTS
(SEAHOLM – LINCOLN STREET ALTERNATIVE)
(Recommended by Interim Business Finance Manager)

MOVED:

WHEREAS, Birmingham Public Schools staff, students and parents developed a ten year facility plan identifying long term capital needs; and

WHEREAS, District voters supported the March 10, 2020 \$195 million bond proposal with 76% approval; and

WHEREAS, Current bond projects permit the purchase of new furniture for the Seaholm / Lincoln Street Alternative; and

WHEREAS, The Project Team, consisting of Integrated Design Solutions, Plante Moran Cresa (PMC), and BPS administration, collaborated to review furniture layout concepts, furniture samples, and finishes; and

WHEREAS, The district maintains consortium memberships through E&I Cooperative Services and Sourcewell Cooperative; and

WHEREAS, Based on thorough discussion, the Project Team recommends that furniture for the spaces listed above be purchased through consortium contract pricing in partnership with local Southeast Michigan furniture vendors;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Board of Education allow the purchase of furniture not to exceed \$75,000 through consortium contract pricing in partnership with local Southeast Michigan furniture vendors for the bond projects listed above.
