15 16 17 18 19 20 21	No person uses any device, whether handheld or otherwise, including but not limited to all wireless telecommunications devices, while driving a school bus, except in the case of an emergency, or when the vehicle is lawfully parked and for the purposes of dispatching. Nothing in this policy prohibits the use of two-way radio devices or wireless telecommunications devices authorized by ACPS that are used hands-free to allow live communication between the driver and the school or public safety officials.
