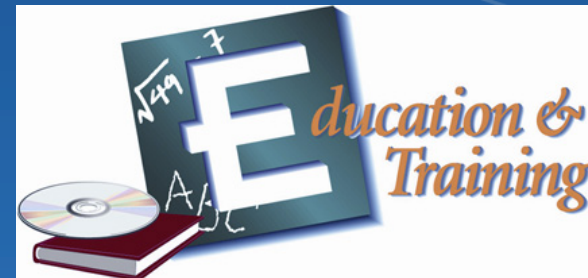
Human Services Career Cluster
