THE 4 STEPS

Principles of Law Enforcement is the start of a strong community of leaders. It explores different careers and opportunities within law enforcement and public services. Students explore, research, and learn to understand the importance and vast array of careers in law enforcement.

Law 1 is the continuation and strengthening of these leaders. In law one, students get hands-on and engaged in the everyday life of police officers. They explore federal and state laws, and the application in real life scenarios. They learn the history, requirements, and duties of the typical American police officer.

Law 2 is the second to last step in the preparation of these leaders for their future law enforcement career. Students get engaged in advanced law enforcement scenarios, tactics, and team building. They will analyze police procedure and apply it to daily instruction through hands-on activities and training.

Practicum is the final and most exciting step of these students' training. This allows students to work alongside detectives, patrol officers, and SROs around Little Elm. This gives the students a feel of the environment they live in and will soon be working in. The safety of the student is always number one priority, but they will ride along with patrol officers, work around the school with SROs, and study cases with Detectives.
