



Mascot & Cheerleader Tryouts

Little Elm High School

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Your child is interested in becoming a member of Little Elm High School cheerleading squad/mascot for the 2023-2024 school year. If selected, your child must assume specific responsibilities and obligations in order to qualify and remain part of the squad.

Things to consider before trying out:

- The cost for each **cheerleader** is approximately:
 - *High School - \$1,400 for a new cheerleader and \$800 for a returner.
 - *Mascot is approximately \$650.
 - *These totals for cheer and mascot includes required uniforms, summer cheerleading camp, and camp uniforms/practice clothes. Uniform/practice clothes - paid up front prior to order in the spring. Opportunities for fundraising to cover costs will be provided.*
- Time Commitment/Summer Camp/Summer Practices/Before & After School Practices/Evening Events
- Fundraising Expectations
- Discipline/Infraction System/Constitutions
- Social Media Expectations

After reading and fully understanding the rules and regulations, please discuss with your child the responsibilities and time commitment expected of Little Elm High School cheerleaders. If your child fully understands what is expected of her/him as a cheerleader or mascot and chooses to try-out, please read over the eligibility requirements and complete the tryout paperwork and turn into Coach Smith by **Friday, March 3rd, 2023 by 2:55 PM.**

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Current physical and cleared (Make a copy and turn in a copy)
2. Turned in Tryout Application and Medical Release Form
3. Turned in the signature page for Acknowledgement of the Constitution.
4. Turned in the signature page for Social Media Contract.
5. Candidates cannot be on any attendance or behavior contract with their House Principal.
6. Candidates must have no DAEP or JJ assignments and no more than 3 ISS or 2 OSS assignments.
7. Any candidate who removes themselves from the program due to circumstances out of their control prior to the end of the current cheer year, may be eligible to try out with approval from the coaches and administration. (Circumstances may include family emergencies, personal medical emergencies, physical/mental illness)

Candidates may wear any lobo colors and athletic shoes for clinics.

Required Apparel for ALL Candidates on the day of Tryouts (Thursday March 9th):

- Black or Navy Athletic Shorts
- Plain White T Shirt or Tank Top
- Clean Athletic Shoes with White Socks
- Hair should be pulled back out of the face.
- Candidates may wear any colored bow and makeup.
- Please wear appropriate undergarments so that your attire is not a distraction during your tryout.
- No jewelry to be worn during clinic or tryouts.
