531.a DRIVERS EDUCATION POLICY

I. PURPOSE

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

Students who are not enrolled in Rothsay Public School may elect to participate in the Driver Education Program. Driver Education includes thirty (30) hours of course work in the classroom, and six hours behind the wheel training. Students must reach the age of fifteen (15) on or before July 15th of the year in which the training occurs.

Fees for Driver Education will be charged which are identical to the students' resident district or the district in which they are enrolled. Independent School "District #850 requires a payment (this fee is set by the board at their July board meeting) for drivers' education. However, if a neighboring district student wishes to attend our drivers' education program they may, but must pay what their district charges, unless Rothsay's fee is higher. Should a student desire to participate in one of the two course requirements, the fee will be pro-rated according to the district of enrollment.

Students who take drivers education from a Rothsay School sponsored program must be on their best behavior. If discipline or any sort is required the student will be removed from class, a pro-rated amount of money returned and the student must then go elsewhere.
