2022-2023 Prekindergarten Family Engagement Plan

The Santa Anna School District and Elementary Campus focus on meaning parent involvement from parents, community members, and other stakeholder. Our expectation is to build positive relationships between the schools and the families in our community.

1. Facilitate Family-to-Family Support

Create a safe and respectful environment to ensure opportunities for continuous participation in events where families can learn from each other and social events to connect with one another such as:

2. Establish a Network of Community Resources

3. Increase Family Participation in Decision-Making

Encourage family engagement and participation in decision making to support and impact positive achievement:

- Inviting parents as participants in the development of continuous improvement plan

4. Equip Families with Tools to Enhance and Extend Learning

5. Developing Staff Skills in Evidence-Based Practices that Support Families in Meeting their Children's Learning Benchmarks.

Emphasize awareness of Parental Involvement and promote family engagement as a core strategy to improve teaching and learning among all educators and staff.
