Position Summary:

School Counselor

Responsibilities include:

- Develop and implement the four strands of counseling services as outlined in the International School Counselor's Model (American School Counselor's Association), in consultation with the Head of School, Division Principals, the Head of Student Support Services, and the current Junior/Secondary School counselors.
- Provide support services for individual student planning at the designated grade levels
- Provide structured in-class guidance lessons as part of the overall pastoral care program at the designated grade levels
- Support tutors and Administration in developing and documenting the Secondary school pastoral care program
- Provide response services for students/families in crisis situations and act as advisor for administration as requested
- Serve as a member of the ISH Child Protection Team
- Attend all SSST meetings and sub-meetings relating to counseling
- Consult with other international schools/AGIS schools to stay current in standards of practice for school counselors
- Observe all ISH standards, protocols and policies
- Engage in on-going professional development and training relating to international school counseling.
- Carry out responsibilities with a clear team orientation, supporting all group and/or management decisions once they have been taken.

Qualifications:

Applicants must have a Master's level degree in counseling or a related field, as well as experience in the delivery of counseling services within a school setting for both students and families. Experience and training in the International School Counseling Model, as well as pastoral care programs is advantageous. Knowledge of psychological testing and the German language is also beneficial.



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Terms of Employment:

- Starting date is 1 August 2023
- The position is initially limited until 31 July 2025, with an option for a permanent position thereafter
- The position is a full-time position
