New payment information

\$200 Summer school fee may be made with a check made payable to Sycamore high school, or it can be paid via your Infinite Campus portal once class rosters are set on May 1 st . Last day to make your payment is May 12 th. ***Failure to make the payment will result in your student being removed from the class roster.***

All outstanding/past fees must be paid in full by May 12 th

Completed registration applications can be dropped off in the main office with Mrs.Wolf.

Space in specific programs may be limited and fill quickly. Application for registration is not a guarantee of entry in a given program. Students will be admitted to each program on a first-come, first-served basis and only if all fees have been paid. If a class closes due to full enrollment, students may be placed on a waiting list. Placement on the waiting list is not a guarantee of eventual enrollment in the desired class.

Minimum class size will be 15 students. Classes not having a minimum enrollment may be canceled. Courses will be offered contingent upon the number of students and availability of an instructor. If courses are canceled, money will be refunded.

There will be no special education services offered for this class.

Requirements

Students in SHS Summer School are expected to follow all rules and regulations set forth in the Sycamore High School Parent-Student Handbook. ***Student attendance is required.*** Students must arrive at summer classes on time. Two tardies will be equivalent to one absence. Students will be allowed **ONLY** one absence for any reason. Students who accumulate two or more absences for any reason will be dropped from the summer program, forfeiting credit for the course. Registration fees for summer school are non-refundable if a student has to be removed. Payment is due at the time of application.
